

Bilan 2017-2023

“Méi no. Méi Maacher.” We stand for an attractive city of Grevenmacher, for proactive politics, solidarity and empathy towards the residents of Grevenmacher. Close to our citizens.

Between 2012 and the end of 2023, we would have invested up to 130 million euros in housing, sports and cultural infrastructure, and road construction. We want to continue our projects. We want to continue rendering Grevenmacher even more attractive, sustainable and close to our residents. Quality of life of all of us is our major concern.

Important investments into the improvement of the quality of life for our residents. Working, living and leisure in Grevenmacher: More Grevenmacher. More “Miseler Way of Life!”

Our priorities in 2017 were:

- Creation of housing,
- Investments into various local infrastructures,
- Safety
- Expansion of the economic, touristic and cultural activities in Grevenmacher.

Housing / urban development:

- New PAG,
- New housing (e.g. Gilgesgässel, rue Syr), together with SNHBM and “Fonds de Logement”: affordable housing in the “Kahlebiërg” and on “Réngmauerstrooss”,
- Implementation of the PAP Pietert: housing for up to 250 new residents, plots of the municipality will be offered as affordable housing through long-term leasehold agreements,
- New PAP's, such as PAP in “Paradäis” and on “rue de Wecker”,
- Planning of the PAP “Op Flohr”.

Public infrastructures:

- New public underground parking with 100 parking spaces on ‘Réngmauerstrooss’,
- Plans for a second public underground car park under the new cultural centre: 80 parking spaces,
- Parking in ‘rue Victor Prost’,
- Plans for a new bus station,
- Plans for the new market place,
- Modernisation of roads and underground infrastructures, such as water pipes, gas pipes and electricity (e.g. On ‘rue Boland’, ‘rue Victor Prost’, ‘rue des Bateliers’, ‘Kellereistrooss’),
- Street lights for pedestrian crossings,
- Renovation of house No. 3 at ‘Place du Marché’, expansion of the municipal hall,
- Plans for a new municipal equipment hall,
- Plans for the landscaping of the parking lot near the municipal swimming pool.

Security:

- Cooperation between the police and municipal agents,
- Camera systems in public spaces,
- Improvement of safety measures at pedestrian crossings,
- Implementation of the 'safe way to school' concept,
- 30 kmh zones in residential areas and plans for 20-30 kmh zones around the school,
- Opposition to the construction of further oil tanks in the harbour of Mertert.
