

## **CSV – Election program for the municipal elections 2023**

### **I. Priorities**

1. Completion of the new cultural centre with underground parking
2. Construction of a new bus station and the 'Schweinsmoart'
3. Expansion of the elementary school and the 'Maison relais' (daycare centre)
4. The redesign of the marketplace
5. The 3rd phase of the Mosel promenade (between the playground and the tennis court)
6. A new technical hall for the municipal service
7. Housing construction
8. Financial support for the cooperation between doctors' practices
9. No expansion of the fuel depots

### **II. Our ideas for the municipal elections**

#### **1. Housing construction**

- A "multigenerational house", e.g. B. at the corner of 'Stued' and 'rue Victor Prost'
- A shared residential community for young people, e.g. in the house next to the roundabout 'Kummert'
- 'PAP' 'Pietert'
- 'PAP' 'Op Flohr'

#### **2. Infrastructures / Urbanism**

- The redesign of the marketplace
- The 3rd phase of the 'Muselpromenade' (between the playground and the tennis court)
- A new technical hall for the municipal service
- Shared space, e.g. 'Poststroos' to 'Spuerkeess'
- A forest cemetery / vineyard cemetery
- The remodelling of the BBQ space at 'Fooscht' + 'Funpark'
- A flexible sail covering the courtyard of the 'Kulturhuef'
- The redesign of the 'Schiltzeplaz'
- The implementation of the concept 'Design for All' with access for disabled people to public infrastructures

### **3. Mobility/traffic**

- Further speed reduction in residential areas
- The development of cycling paths in and around Grevenmacher and the wider region
- Increasing safety around and on pedestrian crossings
- The redesign of A1 motorway entry and exit at 'Potaschberg'
- The simplification of the residential parking system with a maximum of 1-2 zones
- Lobbying for the construction of a bridge over the harbour to the A1
- Elaboration of possible solutions for a better traffic flow in the 'Kummert' roundabout
- The implementation of a 30 km/h zone around the school infrastructure and the nursing home
- Further installation of charging stations for electric cars
- Sidewalk for pedestrians along the sports complex 'Op Flohr'

### **4. Security**

- Adequate lighting
- Further installations of video surveillance cameras in sensitive locations
- A closer cooperation between the police and municipal agents in order to control minor crimes such as vandalism, etc.
- Lobbying for a police station in the centre of Grevenmacher, e.g. in the old police building

### **5. School**

- Expansion of the elementary school and the 'Maison relais'  
The continuation of the transport of children from reception structures to leisure activities
- The introduction of the 'Pedibus'
- Holiday activities for children
- Participation to the construction of a state-funded indoor swimming pool in the 'rue du Centenaire'

### **6. Economics**

- The creation of a 'co-working space'
- Premises for start-ups, e.g. at 'Potaschberg'
- The expansion of the 'PAP' in the trade and craft zone 'Rue de Flaxweiler'
- The expansion of the industrial zone SIAEG at 'Potaschberg'

- The Financial Center at 'Potaschberg'

## **7. Social**

- An anti-waste fridge in public area
- A 'weekend of volunteering'
- A helpline for people in need
- Supporting the development of social structures
- Continued support for the service 'Sick children at home' and for the 'school for parents'
- Continued financial support for socially disadvantaged persons, as well as for families, e.g. the introduction of 'Pampersgeld'
- Social housing within the framework of 'PAP' 'Pietert' and 'PAP' 'Op Flohr'

## **8. Integration**

- A new concept for the 'Festival of Nations'
- The implementation of the 'integration plan'
- Reinvigoration of the language café
- The implementation of the 'pact of coexistence'

## **9. Health**

- Financial support for the cooperation between doctors' offices , so that an emergency service can also be offered on Saturdays and Sundays
- Support for the expansion of the medical centre at 'Potaschberg'
- Support for preventive medicine
- Continuation of a first aid training for mental health

## **10. Culture**

- Completion of the new cultural centre with underground parking
- Expansion of the 'Kulturhuef' to create a 'creative space' for artists
- Continuation of the 'Maacher Musel Musekfestival'
- Renovation of the old town hall in order to expand the public library
- Permanent exhibitions on the Moselle promenade

## **11. Tourism**

- The start of the tourist season in collaboration with the business association, the 'Kulturhuef' and the 'SITG' (Tourist Office)
- Animation on the waterstairs and on the Moselle Promenade
- Permanent exhibitions along the Moselle promenade
- Expansion of the bicycle network in and around Grevenmacher and in the wider region
- Installation of 'Litfass' columns
- A youth hostel and further hotel infrastructure in cooperation with private investors
- Promotion of oenotourism
- Introduction of a 'Maacher Leisure Card'
- Further expansion of the 'EuroWelcome Label' concept for access to tourist attractions for disabled people

## **12. Sports**

- Recruiting of a sports coordinator
- Organisation of e-sports events in the new cultural centre
- Expansion of a paddle court (a modified version of tennis) near the tennis courts
- Expanding the sports infrastructure at 'Op Flohr'

## **13. Seniors**

- Continuation of the municipal plan for seniors, e.g. additional senior-friendly benches, lower sidewalks, a barrier-free 'Zone de rencontre' at the new 'Moartplaz'
- Simplified access to the digital world through training, e.g. the continuation of the concept 'old meets young' in collaboration with CRIAJ
- A 'multigenerational house', e.g. in 'Stued' corner / 'rue Victor Prost'
- Premises for seniors
- Support for the collaboration with the Senior Club

## **14. Youth and leisure**

- A digital city plan for children
- Premises for young people
- Remodelling of the grill place at 'Fooscht' and 'Funpark'
- Introduction of a 'Maacher Leisure Card'
- Continuation of the concept 'old meets young' in collaboration with CRIAJ

## **15. Environment**

- Creation of a 'repair workshop'
- Reduction of waste through targeted information campaigns
- Installation of solar panels above the parking lots and on public buildings
- Adaptation of the building regulations to renewable energies
- Continuation of investments in green areas in our city
- 'Urban gardening'
- Continuation of financial support for investments in sustainable energies
- Continuation of the rehabilitation of the municipal springs at 'Geyeschhaff'
- Reduction and avoidance of light pollution
- Anti-waste fridge in public area
